TIPS

- ✓ Talk over your choice to go Test Optional or not with a counselor or Mr. Humphreys and check each colleges' policy.
- ✓ Plan to take your best test, ACT or SAT, 2-3 times if that fits your plans.
- ✓ Most colleges "**superscore**" your highest SAT/ACT sections, so they make an overall highest score from your best sections across all test dates. Check if your colleges superscore.
- ✓ What's a "good score"? Look at Naviance admissions scattergrams and your colleges' scholarship targets to see what will help you. Remember it's only one factor and it's not as important as courses and grades!
- ✓ Private Test Prep Classes Mr. Humphreys has a list of local companies in his room
- ✓ Saying "Yes" to the SAT Student Search Service gets you all that college mail! You can opt out.
