UVA Cornerstone Summer Class on Slavery & Segregation

You are cordially invited to apply to the University of Virginia's <u>Cornerstone Summer</u> <u>Institute</u>. Originally created by the UVA President's Commission on Slavery and the University (PCSU) and now run by the President's Commission on the University in the Age of Segregation (PCUAS), the Cornerstone Summer Institute focuses on history, archaeology, and community engagement. The camp runs June 23 to June 30, 2023 at the University of Virginia.

Rising sophomores, juniors, and seniors will explore the early history of the University by getting hands-on experience with archival records, by rolling up their sleeves as they work on an archaeological dig, and by learning through community engagement how the UVA story had an impact on the surrounding community.

During their time in the program, students will live the UVA experience: residing in dorms, eating in dining halls, meeting new friends, and exploring the Jefferson-designed school. Guided by top faculty and a team of UVA students, participants will explore both the University's past and the modern-day legacies of slavery.
