






Guaranteed Admissions Agreements (GAA)





- □Cumulative GPA (weighted or unweighted) of 3.5 or higher; or
- □ combined SAT totaling 1200 or higher; or
- □ combined ACT totaling 25 or higher.



- Complete NOVA Application at <u>www.nvcc.edu</u>
 - Receive your NOVA Student ID Number & MyNOVA login information
- 2. Apply for Financial Aid via the FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov
- Log into your MyNOVA account & get pending Holds and To Do List items remove
- 4. Apply for in-state tuition (if applicable)
- 5. English & Math Placement
 - Access your <u>unofficial</u> mid-year Senior transcript, SAT/ACT, AP/IB exam scores, TOEFL-iBT, ILETS, or GED scores
- 6. Complete NOVA's Online **Orientation**
- 7. Seek **Advising** (if needed)
- 8. Enroll/Register in NOVA classes via your MyNOVA account
- 9. Pay Tuition (via financial aid, scholarships, out-of-pockets, etc)
- 10. **Prep** for start of classes Obtain NOVA ID card, textbooks/supplies, parking permit (if needed)



How will you pay for college?



- FAFSA (www.fafsa.ed.gov) –to be eligible for:
 - grants (money you don't pay back "gift aid")
 - <u>loans</u> (money you pay back with interest)
 - <u>Subsidized</u> vs <u>Unsubsidized</u> Loan The federal government pays the interest for Subsidized Loans while student is in college or while the loan is in deferment. Interest begins accruing for Unsubsidized Loans as soon as the loan is taken out
 - On average, college borrowers graduate with \$24,000 to \$29,500 in federal student loan debt.
 - work-study (work for NOVA, max 20 hours/week, must work around classes)
- Scholarships Money is out there-you just have to apply for it!
 - Start your search with the career center rep. at your high school and online.
 - MANY DEADLINES ARE BETWEEN JANUARY-APRIL

- *small enrollment fee
- *the earlier you sign up, the better the plan!

- Scholarships specifically available to DREAMers to help pay for college (deadline TBA)
- Must be DACA, TPS (Temporary Protected Status), or certify that you meet the following immigration eligibility criteria:
 - Came to the United States before the age of 16
 - Came to the country before November 1, 2015
- Graduated or will graduate with a GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale
