



Dual Enrollment

• DE allows high school juniors and seniors to earn high school and college credit simultaneously. Saves time and money when completing a bachelor's degree. Many courses transfer to 4-year schools.

Early Online College

- Opportunity for high school juniors and seniors* to take tuition-free college courses in an online asynchronous format. Students are responsible for textbooks and other course material purchases. May take a maximum of two (2) courses per semester.


