

## ROTC Scholarship Information

As of September 2023

**REMINDER:** You must apply for and be accepted for BOTH the ROTC Scholarship and admission to the University of your choice.

#### Application Deadlines:

- U.S. Space Force career track - November 30, 2023, to submit an initial application; December 31, 2023, to submit all remaining application materials.
- U.S. Air Force career track - December 31, 2023, to submit an initial application; January 11, 2024, to submit all remaining application materials.

Type 1 Scholarship – Pays full tuition for four years and authorized fees at any public or private institution with an Air Force ROTC detachment. Type 1 selectees will also receive a monthly living expense stipend and an annual book stipend. Note: AFROTC Scholarships do not cover room and board.

#### Requirements:

- Applicant should have a SAT of 1240 or ACT of 26. Applicants unable to secure a test prior to the application deadline should contact their scholarship technician.
- Applicant should have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Applicants must pass a Department of Defense Medical Examination Review Board (DoDMERB) medical exam. Applicants will either be scheduled to take the physical exam at the nearest military base or be sent to a designated civilian contractor.
- Applicant must complete a Physical Fitness Assessment (PFA) which consists of three events: push-ups, sit-ups, and a 1.5-mile run.
- Once you meet the academic and fitness requirements, you will then be scheduled for an interview with a local Air Force unit.
- Applicants must be a United States citizen or be able to obtain citizenship by the last day of the first term of their freshman year.
- If you are the sole provider for another person (e.g., single parent, guardian for younger sibling, etc.), please contact the nearest Air Force ROTC detachment admissions representative for dependent care plan information.

#### SERVICE OBLIGATION - YOU WILL AGREE TO:

- Enroll in the academic major for which the scholarship is offered.
  - Enroll in Air Force ROTC beginning with the upcoming fall term.
  - Complete a 13-day summer field training course at Maxwell AFB, Alabama, between sophomore and junior years.
  - Complete Air Force ROTC General Military Course (GMC) your freshman and sophomore years and the Professional Officer Course (POC) your junior and senior years.
  - Accept a commission as an Air Force officer and serve at least four years on active duty.

Applications opened on June 12, 2023. Applications must be started no later than Mar. 4, 2024 to be eligible for review by the Army ROTC National Scholarship Board. Here are the application and board review dates for the 2022-2023 school year:

- **Applications are due by Oct. 9, 2023** to be reviewed by the board from Oct. 16-20, 2023
- **Applications are due by Jan. 15, 2024** to be reviewed by the board from Jan. 22-26, 2024
- **Applications are due by Mar. 11, 2024** to be reviewed by the board from Mar. 18-22, 2024

High school students who apply for ROTC are eligible for scholarships covering up to the full cost of tuition, plus money for personal expenses and books.

- [Locate](#) and contact the Recruiting Operations Officer at the school you plan to attend—most of them have served before and understand the process you're going through

Requirements:

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be at least 17
- Have a high school GPA of at least 2.50
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Have taken the SAT or ACT
- Meet physical standards
- Agree to accept a commission and serve in the Army on Active Duty or in a Reserve Component (Army Reserve or Army National Guard)

YOUR COMMITMENT

- Eight years of Army service, with requirements for active duty in the Army, and/or serving in the Army Reserve or Army National Guard, depending on the scholarship
  - You may be eligible to serve part time in the Army Reserve or Army National Guard while pursuing a civilian career immediately after graduation

Student may apply for only one of three program options: Navy, Marine Corps, Nurse.

Application Deadline: January 31, 2024

High school students who apply for NROTC are eligible for scholarships covering up to the full cost of tuition, plus money for personal expenses and books.

### Requirements:

- U.S. Citizenship
- At least 17 years old by Sept 1 of the year applicant starts college and no more than 23 on September 1 of that year.
- Have acquired a high school graduation or equivalency certificate by August 1 of the year you plan to enter the NROTC program
- Be medically qualified and meet height and weight Navy standards.
- Apply for and gain admission to an approved Navy ROTC school.
- Navy and Nurse Application SAT: 540 Math; 550 Evidence Based Reading and Writing AND 1100 Combined (Math plus Evidence Based Reading and Writing) ACT: 21 Math; 22 English AND 44 Combined (Math plus English) *Navy Application Only - Applicants with the minimum individual Math and Verbal scores but not the combined score, and who respond positively to the MSISR interest question in the application, are eligible to apply and will be considered on the MSISR selection board.*
- Marine Application SAT minimum combined score of 1000 on the Math and Evidence Based Reading and Writing portions of the test ACT minimum composite score of 22. Armed Forces Qualification Test (AFQT) minimum score of 74
